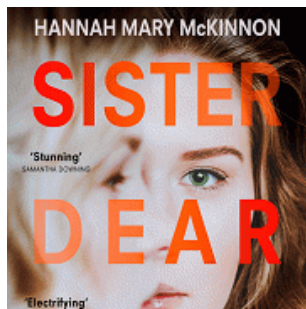


Hodder buys three suspense novels from Hannah Mary McKinnon

Deal covers new novel *Sister Dear* plus two backlist titles from HarperCollins US

Hodder & Stoughton has acquired *Sister Dear*, 'the darkly compelling, completely gripping thriller by Hannah Mary McKinnon', and two of McKinnon's backlist novels - *The Neighbours* and *Her Secret Son*.

Senior commissioning editor Eve Hall acquired UK & Commonwealth rights from Jennifer Choi at Harper Collins US. *Sister Dear* will be published in ebook and audio this June, with a paperback publishing in October.

According to the acquisition statement: '*Sister Dear* tells the story of Eleanor Hardwick who, after finding out that she isn't biologically related to the man she has always known as her father, discovers she also has an infuriatingly enviable half-sister. Perfectly perfect Victoria has everything that Eleanor doesn't. And it gets her thinking - aren't good sisters supposed to share?'

Hall said: "*Sister Dear* is an enthralling novel of obsession, bitterness, revenge, and sisterhood. I read this in one day and knew I had to publish it. McKinnon's plotting is perfectly twisty and her writing is excellent. I'm thrilled to be part of the team."

McKinnon said: "I'm excited and deeply honoured to see *Sister Dear* published by Hodder & Stoughton, and I can't wait to introduce more of the world to these twisted sisters."
