


THE REVENGE LIST

Discussion Questions

Please note these questions contain **spoilers**. You may wish to review them after you've finished the novel.



- 1) What did you make of Frankie's anger issues and the way she dealt with them? Were they justified? What might you have done in the various situations Frankie found herself in?
- 2) How did you feel about Frankie's guilt surrounding her mother's death? Can you imagine blaming yourself in that situation? What could or should Finn have done to help her through it?
- 3) How do you think Frankie may have grown up to be as an adult if her mother hadn't died? Was that the life-defining event for her from which everything in her life spiraled or was it something else?
- 4) What do you make of Frankie's statement "Truth is, we all carry some degree of anger inside, every single one of us"?
- 5) What do you make of Frankie's belief there's a double standard when it comes to how anger is perceived in men and women? Have you encountered the same disparity? How do you think anger should be managed?
- 6) Did your allegiances shift at any point during the story? Toward whom, why, and when?
- 7) What scene was the most pivotal in the story for you? How would the novel have changed if it had been different, or hadn't taken place? What did you expect to happen?
- 8) What surprised or shocked you the most? What didn't you see coming? What was obvious?
- 9) How did you feel about Frankie wanting to shield Sherry and Lawrence from what their son did? Would you have told them the truth if you'd been Frankie, never mind the consequences?
- 10) How do you feel about the ending? What do you think might happen if or when Frankie and Jeremy meet again?
